How to get your rabbit ready for show

- a) Rabbits need to be in a state of excellent health.
- b) They need to have clean ears, eyes, nose, vent area, tail, coat and foot pads.
- c) Staining of the fur or foot pads will result in points been taken off.
- d) Toenails must not be overgrown and should be clipped.
- e) Make sure that there is no matting of the fur in long haired breeds e.g. Angora and Jersey Woolly.



Show procedure

1) After your entry has been received, we will then send you the confirmation of your entry with your rabbit's ear numbers. We usually send this out a week before the show.

You may write this number in your rabbit's ear with a black marker the day of the show. If you are unsure about this, then we will write the number in during vetting in.

2) Arrive on the day at 10:30 am for vetting in with your rabbits in secure escape proof carriers or travelling cages.

Vetting in is when a vetting officer checks your rabbit for sickness, disease and parasites.

3) Judging will take place as soon as all rabbits have been vetted in. You will present your own rabbit to the judge on the judging table.

4) After judging has been complete we will then write out the prize cards and present the prize to the winner.

Rules for show

- All exhibitors need to provide food and water for their own rabbits and bowls or water drinking bottles need to remain filled at all times.
- All rabbits to be in their own secure carriers or travelling cages with enough clean bedding.
- No rabbits less than three months old at the show.

Rules regarding infectious and contagious diseases

Rabbits showing any signs of, or having recent exposure to contagious or infectious disease are not permitted to enter the show premises. These conditions include but are not limited to the following:

- **SKIN & HEAD**

No visible evidence of skin infections, discharge from the eyes or nose or excessive head shaking with particular emphasis on **Ear mites, Fleas, Fur mites and ringworm.**

- **RESPIRATORY**

No signs of infectious respiratory diseases such as sneezing, white nasal discharge or excessive tearing which are all common signs of **Snuffles**.

- **INTESTINAL**

No evidence of soft droppings, soiling on rump or hocks consistent with **Diarrhea**.

What to bring to the show

- Food for your rabbits (pellets and treats, carrots, apples, parsley etc) whatever you normally feed your rabbit.
- Your rabbit's own food and water bowls or water drinking bottle.
